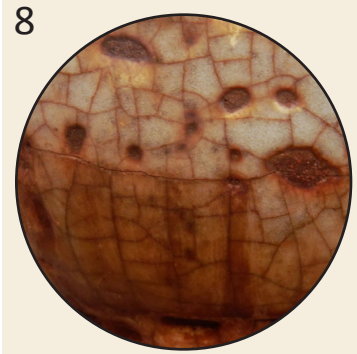
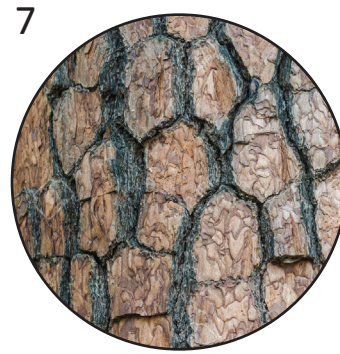
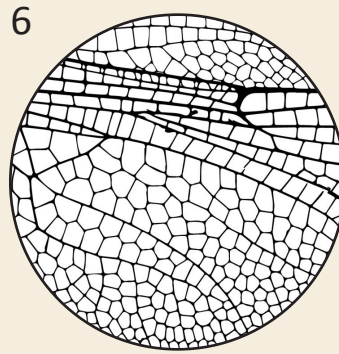
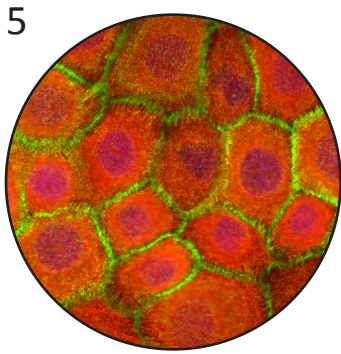
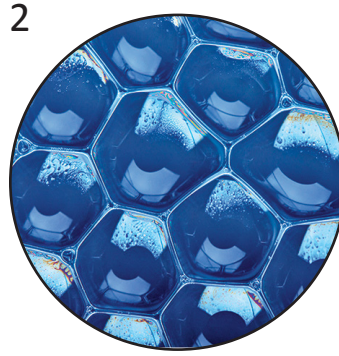
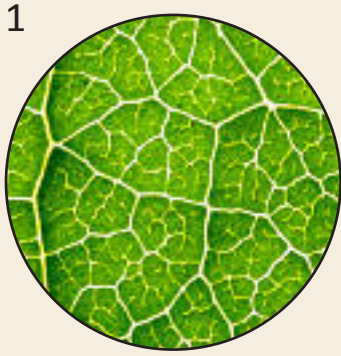


# Finding Patterns in Nature
