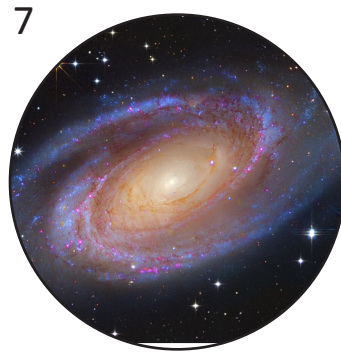
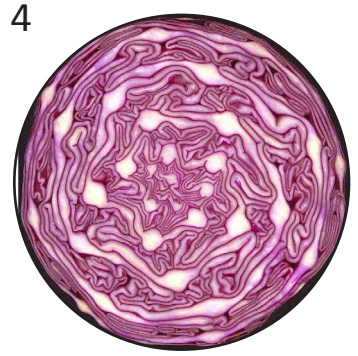
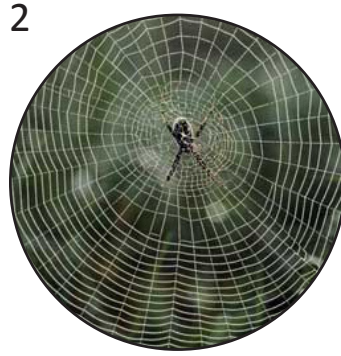


Finding Patterns in Nature
